DRAWBRIDGE INN & CONVENTION CENTER

The American Pomeranian Club has reserved a block of rooms for a special rate of \$89.00 plus applicable taxes per night. Reserve a double or king room 1-4 guests for this rate. The \$89.00 rate will be good from March 13-17, 2010. Reservation deadline will be February 14, 2010. When making your reservations be sure to state that you are with the American Pomeranian Club Dog Show. The hotel requires a \$50.00 pet fee and of which \$25.00 will be refunded if no damage to room. A maximum of 10 crates is allowed per room. The Drawbridge will provide a sheet or bedspread to cover the existing bedspread for protection. A replacement charge will be assessed for any bedspreads, blankets, sheets, etc. damaged or destroyed. The Drawbridge requires that all dogs, left unattended in guestrooms, be locked in crates. Housekeepers will not service rooms where dogs are loose and unattended. Please use door hangers provided. The Drawbridge requires plastic under crates in rooms.

The Drawbridge Inn is a full service hotel featuring, lounge, full service restaurant, room service, pools, fitness room, sauna, video game room, wi-fi, guest laundry and more. A dog washing area will be provided. Hotel guests enjoy the convenience of complimentary airport shuttle service from the Greater Cincinnati/Northern KY International Airport when staying at the Drawbridge Inn Hotel. The shuttle departs the hotel at the top and half past each hour on an as needed basis. From Indianapolis - I-74 East to I-75 South to Exit 186 (Buttermilk Pike), left off the exit. Left at 2nd light onto Royal Drive.

From Huntington WV - I-64 West to I-75 North to Exit 186 (Buttermilk Pike), right off the exit. Left at 1st light onto Royal Drive.

Judging - The judging will start promptly. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. Unentered dogs are not allowed in the show or grooming area.

The American Pomeranian Club and the Hotel assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by an exhibitor, agent, spectator, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for children. The welfare of the child of an exhibitor or as a spectator is assumed to be the responsibility of that person. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors or spectators will use control and restraint over their children at this show.

The Show Committee anticipates limited indoor crating and grooming room. The Club requires that crates be stacked and reserves the right to allocate grooming space for the convenience of all.

All space is available on a first-come-first-served basis.

Exhibitors and Handlers will be held responsible for the clean conditions in and around their grooming area.

No dogs will be allowed in the restrooms.

No Ringside Tables, Grooming or Crating will be allowed in the ballroom.

No puppies under 6 months allowed in grooming area or ballroom.

CELL PHONE MUST BE KEPT ON VIBRATE WHILE IN GROOMING AREA OR BALLROOM. THEY ARE NOT ALLOWED IN RING.

The Club wishes to maintain a good reputation with the Drawbridge Inn management. There will be designated exercise area outside the building. All exhibitors are expected to comply with the exercise area signs.

All Catalogs will be sold. None will be given away.

There will be a RESERVED SECTION for judges who are participating in ringside mentoring. This area will be for JUDGES and MENTORS ONLY.

The Drawbridge Inn is a dog friendly hotel. PLEASE help keep it dog friendly by observing these rules! Immediately after checking in, make a thorough check of your room and report any damages to the Front Desk as well as the Show Chairperson.

Hotel and housekeeping staff will inspect all rooms daily and will report any problems to the Show Chairperson. You will be held financially responsible for any damage to the room.

Create your dogs when not in the room. Protect the carpeting by placing crates and ex-pens on plastic sheeting.

Do not use hotel towels for drying dogs.

Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with credit cards, check drawn on U.S. Accounts or with international money orders in U.S. Funds.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

CANINE COURTESY All dogs shall be kept under control at all times. You are responsible for picking up after the animals in your care.

PLEASE EXERCISE DOGS IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY There will be pooper scoopers and containers placed around the grounds. PLEASE USE THEM. All regulations will be enforced by the Grounds Committee.
