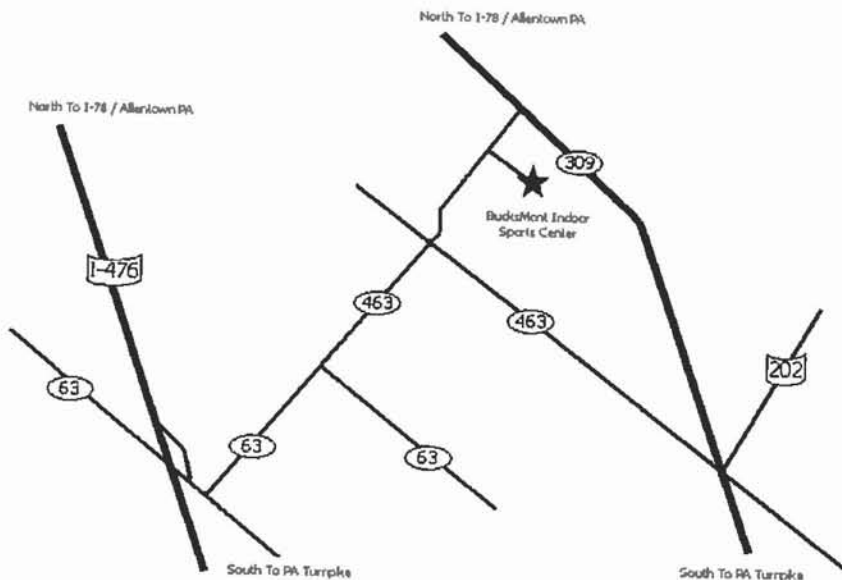
### Directions to the BucksMont Indoor Sports Center 2278 North Penn Road, Hatfield, PA 19440

From the North East Extension of the PA Turnpike (I-476):

- Take Exit 31 towards Lansdale.
- Turn left at Summertown Pike.
- Turn left at Forty Foot Road and follow Forty Foot Road for 3 miles where it will become E. Broad Street.
- Take E. Broad for 0.2 miles and turn left onto E. Lincoln Avenue/Market Street.
- Follow Lincoln/Market for 0.2 miles and take the first right onto Unionville Pike.
- Travel 0.7 miles on Unionville Pike and then turn right on North Penn Road to show site.

From Route 309:

- From 309 South, turn right on Unionville Pike. From 309 North, Turn left on Unionville Pike.
- Travel 0.5 miles to North Penn Road and turn right to show site.



### ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

**Parking:** Free parking.

No overnight parking available.

#### \* NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS \*

**CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.**

**DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

**JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**ALL DOGS PRESENT** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

**CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of the trial is over, and the Superintendent to be advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the trial is over.

**THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229. An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries. Effective January 1, 2009 - Refund and Cash award checks are void after 180 days and will NOT be re-issued. In the case of a bitch in season, refund of all but \$5.00 of the entry fee will be returned upon sending a statement to the trial secretary postmarked before the day of the trial.

Entry shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by the trial committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees shall be made.
