Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Classes: For any dog or bitch which is 7 years old or older prior to the date of this show. Classes shall be divided: 7 years and under 10 years, 10 years and over. Sexes divided. As a symbol of respect to all entrants only a First Placement will be awarded in each Veteran Class. The first place winner in non-regular classes, i.e. Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch and which have been undeleated in any other class, will be eligible for Best of Breed Competition. At an independent breed specialty show when there is no competition, beyond Best of Breed, a dog or bitch that is 7 years or older and that has been neutered or spayed may compete.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dog and two (2) or three (3) of his get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the get. A single entry fee of \$35.00 will be charged for this class unless the get are not entered in any other regular or non-regular class in which case it shall be entered for Stud Dog Class ONLY and the regular entry fee shall be paid. \$25.00 as an additional entry (unit)

Brood Bitch Class: Same as stud except substitute produce for get and Brood Bitch for Stud Dog. Brood Class: (Two entries identical ownership not required). Will require a fee of \$35.00 as a UNIT. The dogs comprising a Brood Class MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brood is not entered in another class, it must be marked "For Brood Only", fee is \$25.00 per dog. In making entries for "Brood Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brood MUST be marked accordingly in place provided for Additional Classes - "Brood Class".

Obedience Trial Classes

Dogs that have completed a title may move up to the next level provided there is no conflict regarding the Judge and/or any Class limitations. Obedience Fee: \$26.00 for first entry.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW GROUNDS

From North & South Via Interstate 295: Take 295 to Exit 65A, Sloane Avenue. East on Sloane Avenue to Second traffic light, Quaker Bridge Road. Cross over Quaker Bridge Road and go to next traffic light (road makes a T) at Old Trenton/Edinburg Road (Route 535). Turn left onto Old Trenton/Edinburg Road, Mercer County park is about two miles ahead on left.
From North Via U.S. 1: Take US 1 South of Princeton to Rt. 533, Quaker Bridge Road. Bear Right off US 1 into Hughes Drive and cross over US 1 onto Rt. 533, Quaker Bridge Road. Travel 2.2 miles and turn left onto Hughes Drive. At the first traffic light, turn left onto Old Trenton/Edinburg Road, Route 535. Travel about 1.5 miles on Route 535 to the exhibitors' entrance to the Park on the left.
From South Via U.S. Route 1: Cross toll bridge into New Jersey. On U.S. 1 make first right past Quaker Bridge Mall onto Quaker Bridge Road (Route 533). Travel 2.2 miles and turn left onto Hughes Drive. Make left at traffic light onto Old Trenton/Edinburg Road (Route 535) and proceed to the exhibitor's entrance about 1.85 miles on left.
From North (Route 130S) Turnpike Exit 8 A: Exit 8 A toward Rt. 130 South. Go to the 6th light and turn right onto Old Trenton Road (Rt. 535). Go through 4 traffic lights. MC Park is on right just ahead.
From South Via NJ Route 130/206: Follow Route 130 North to Route 526 in Robbinstonville. Turn left at traffic light onto Route 526. (Corners: Coastal Delta Station, Hussert's Deli). Turn right at the next traffic light; you are still on Route 526. From this point travel 3 miles to Route 535, Old Trenton/Edinburg Road and turn left. The exhibitor's entrance to the show grounds is about 1/3 miles ahead on the right side.
From South Via New Jersey Turnpike: Take NJ Turnpike South to Exit 7A. Take Interstate 195 West to Exit 5B which is the first exit on Route 195 To Route 130 North, New Brunswick. Travel North on Route 130 to second traffic light and turn left onto Route 526. Proceed to the next traffic light and turn right (still Route 526). There may be a detour on Rt. 526. Follow signs. Go 3 miles to Route 535 and turn left. The park exhibitors' entrance is 1/3 miles ahead on the right.

CLOSING DATE: for entries 12:00 NOON, Wednesday, April 21, 2010 (at Superintendent's Office) after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

THE SHOW will be open from 8:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of noise, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing services through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

THE SHOW COMMITTEES/SUPERINTENDENT will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or mistreatment to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

CANINE COURTESY: All dogs shall be kept under control at all times. You are responsible for picking up after the animals in your care.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of his breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
