JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Bred-by-Exhibitor (BBE) Class eligibility

- All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC.
- The persons handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Non-Regular Classes - Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Classes - Class for dogs and class for bitches 7 years old or over. Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes at this show.

Non-Regular Classes - Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class - Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class. Fee is \$25.00 for the Stud Dog if not entered in another class; \$20.00 as an additional class.

Brood Bitch Class - Will be for Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class. Fee is \$25.00 for the Brood Bitch if not entered in another class; \$20.00 as an additional class.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Varsity by virtue of having won this class.

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on

the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

ENTRY FEE: \$28.00 for the first entry of each dog except Puppy Classes (6-9 and 9-12 mos) and Breed-by-Exhibitor Classes which are \$22.00 (including \$06 AKC recording fee & \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee) and \$20.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. Junior Showmanship Only, \$17.00. Junior Showmanship as an additional class, \$17.00. Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes (as a first entry) \$25.00. Limited to 50 dogs.

CLOSING DATE for entries 12:00 NOON, Wednesday, March 10, 2010 (a Show Superintendent's Office) after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 5 of the Dog Show Rules.

A RECORDING FEE of \$06 and an AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show. Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2).

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGEMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR within a reasonable time, please notify The Show Superintendent at (610) 376-1980.

MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO J.R.D.S. Ltd. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, who ever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing services through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Show Superintendent to be advised all once. The Show Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and grooming area.

Effective May 1, 2006 an administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

Effective January 1, 2009 - Refund and Cash award checks are void after 180 days and will NOT be re-issued.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

From Route 1 Southbound - Take Route 1 Exit. Exit onto Main Street and go 1/4 mile to the traffic light onto Route 514 East (Woodbridge Avenue). Turn right at the Sheraton Hotel into Raritan Center. Follow the signs to the Expo Center.

From Route 1 Northbound - After crossing the Raritan River Bridge, get into the right lane. After passing "Open Road Honda" take the third/right hand exit onto Route 514 East (Woodbridge Avenue). Follow Woodbridge Avenue for 3 to 4 miles. Make a right at the Sheraton Hotel into Raritan Center. Follow the signs to the Expo Center.

From Route I-287 South - Follow Route I-287 South to the Bonhamtown ONLY. Route 514 West Exit. (This exit is just after the NJ Turnpike Exit). Follow Route 514 West to the first exit ramp marked Raritan Center. Follow the signs to the Expo Center.

From the NJ Turnpike - Follow the NJ Turnpike to Exit 10. Pay the toll, to the right, follow Route 514 West to Raritan Center. Take the first exit marked Raritan Center and follow the signs to the Expo Center.

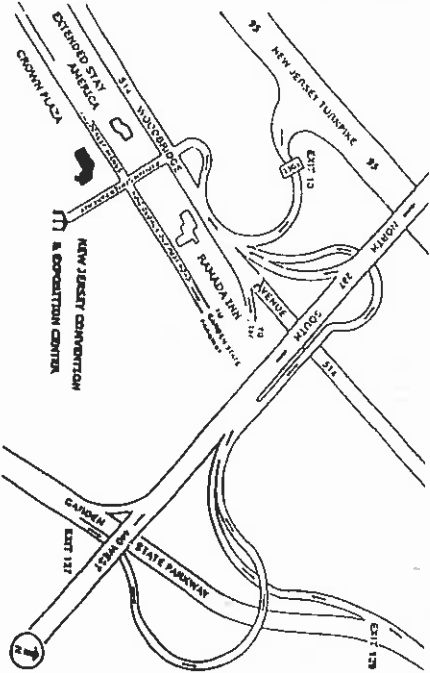

The DNA Repository and The Dalmatian Club of America are pleased to announce that they will be holding DNA Collection Clinics at regional Dalmatian specialties throughout the country.

DNA samples will be collected on the blood samples and will be stored at the University of Missouri-Columbia. Approximately 5-10 cc's of whole blood will be collected per dog. The sample process is quick and should not affect the dog's ability to compete at the show. All collection and storage costs for samples collected during these events will be underwritten by The Dalmatian Club of America Foundation and the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals.

Pre-Registration is not required, although it is recommended and requested that owners complete the required paperwork ahead of time. Forms can be downloaded from the OFA web site www.ofa.net. Forms will also be available the day of the show.

The CHIC DNA Repository, jointly sponsored by the OFA and the AKC/CHC, collects and stores canine DNA samples that will help veterinarians diagnose and determine health problems of individual canine breeds.

Please join the Dalmatian Club of Greater New York on Saturday, March 27, 2010 one hour after the conclusion of Dalmatian judging at the New Brunswick Kennel Club Show for our support of the CHIC DNA Repository. Location will be announced ringside prior to Best of Breed judging. Remember ALL Dalmatians are welcome.
