Veteran Classes: Classes for Dogs & Bitches 7 years and over. Sexes divided.
Gun Dog Classes: Classes for Dogs & Bitches that have an AKC Hunting title and/or an IWSCA Working Certificate and/or an IWSCA Working Certificate Excellent and/or an AKC Field Trial Title. Sexes divided.

Non-Regular Classes (Additional) Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and a minimum of two and a maximum of six of their get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. All Get must be individually entered in one of the breed classes in show for which it is eligible. Entry fee for this class is \$35.00 for the unit.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

As a judges decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Generations Class - Each entry in this Non-Regular Class must represent at least 3 generations of an Irish Water Spaniel pedigree, exhibited from the oldest to the youngest. An entry may be a mix of dogs and bitches. Spayed/neutered dogs may be exhibited in this class. An entry form must be completed for each entry in this class, must be entered in a regular conformation class. In this Generations Class, each entry is evaluated on the merits of all of the dogs presented and the over-all consistency in maintaining the standard of the breed, through the multiple generations.
