**ENTRY FEES: OBEDIENCE & RALLY:** \$26.00 for the first entry of each dog (including \$3.00 A.K.C. Event Service Fee & \$5.00 A.K.C. recording fee is included) and \$20.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. \$20.00 for each entry in a Non-Regular Class.

**CLOSING DATE** for entries 12:00 NOON, Wednesday, April 7, 2010 (at Trial Secretary's Office) after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. **THE SHOW** will be open from 7:30 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.

**An AKC RECORDING FEE of \$5.00 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00** will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient.
