THEY WILL ADHERE AS CLOSELY AS POSSIBLE TO THE JUDGING SCHEDULE.** The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Bayshore Companion Dog Club, Inc., has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**NO DOG MAY BE PERMANENTLY REMOVED** from the Trial before it is judged except by consent of The Bayshore Companion Dog Club, Inc., upon a Veterinarian's recommendation or removal.
