ROUTES TO THE SHOW

From the South or East or West on the Pennsylvania Turnpike: Take the Northeast Extension of the PA Turnpike to Exit 44, Quakertown. Turn Left (North on Route 663) to Route 309. Turn Left (North on Route 309). Go through **Coopersburg to Center Valley** and turn Right on Route 378 North. At second traffic light, turn Right. At first stop sign, turn Left and follow signs to STABLER ARENA, Goodman Campus.

From the North or East or West on Route 22: Exit Route 378 South. Go through **Bethlehem** and at the top of the hill (after going through Bethlehem) turn Left at the traffic light (take jug handle to the right). Keep to the right at two forks in the road and follow the signs to STABLER ARENA, Goodman Campus.

From West I-78 use Exit 67. Turn left onto Rt. 412 South and proceed 1.3 miles to Water St. (3rd traffic light). Turn right onto Water St. and proceed 1.2 miles to Mountain Dr. Turn right at the first light and follow signs to Goodman Campus, Stabler Arena.

From East I-78 use Exit 67. Turn left onto Rt. 412 South and proceed 1.3 miles to Water St. (3rd traffic light). Proceed as above.

Ramps at the sole discretion of the judge, approved breeds may be examined on the ground or on a ramp: Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chow Chows, Chinese Shar-Pei, Clumber Spaniels, Irish Terriers, Keeshound, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Sussex Spaniels, Whippets, Kerry Blue Terriers and Staffordshire Bull Terriers. (Whippets may be examined on the ground, on a table or on a ramp).

- Basset Hounds are expected to be judged on the ramp during breed judging.
- For the Judging of Juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp breeds.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed.

(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AN/OR THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniels (Black, ASCOB, Parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in.; over 13 in, but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (Longhaired, Smooth, Wirehaired), Bull Terriers (Colored, White), Manchester Terriers (Standard, Toy), Chihuahuas (Smooth Coat, Long Coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (Toy, Miniature, Standard), Collies (Rough, Smooth).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list, if the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
