Veteran Classes, For any dog or bitch which is 8 years old & under 10, and 10 years & over. Sexes divided.

Hunting Retriever Classes, Classes for dogs and bitches that have earned an AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter or Master Hunter Title. Sexes divided.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Awards of Merit. The Judge may select up to 10% of the superior quality specimen in addition to the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed from the Intersex Competition.

Parade of Titleholders: There will be a non-competitive Parade of AKC Champions, Obedience, Rally and Agility titleholders. The Long Island Golden Retriever Club offers a Rosette imprinted with the dog's name to each dog exhibited in the Parade.

RIBBON PRIZES

Bred-by-Exhibitor Class eligibility: All dogs entered in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The Person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Non-Regular Classes

Involving Multiple Entries

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dog and two (2) of his get.

Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Award will be based on the merits of the get. If the Get are not entered in one of the other Classes in this show for which it is eligible the regular entry fee must be paid. Entry fee is \$28.00 for Stud Dog Class only, \$18.00 as an additional entry.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

In accordance with Chapter 11, Section 8 - a castrated male may be entered in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligibl for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Veterans Obedience Class, The Veterans Class shall be for dogs that have an obedience title and are seven (7) or more years on the date of the trial. Dogs entered in the Veterans class may not be entered in any Regular Class.

Move Ups will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations Chapter 1, Section 16. No Refund for bitches in season.

Wild Card Novice - is for any dog that is capable of performing the Novice exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person and may be entered in another class or classes. The novice exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Novice class, except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to skip one exercise and receive full credit for that exercise.

When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be skipped. If an exercise is skipped, it cannot be performed. If the handler chooses to perform all of the exercises, all will be scored. The exercises will be performed in the same order as the regular Novice class. The point values for the exercises, scoring and maximum total points are the same as the regular Novice class.

Wild Card Open - is for any dog that is capable of performing the Open exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person and may be entered in another class or classes. The Open exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Open A class, except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to skip one exercise and receive full credit for that exercise. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be skipped. If an exercise is skipped, it cannot be performed. If the handler chooses to perform all of the exercises, all will be scored. The exercises will be performed in the same order as the regular Open A class. The point values for the exercises, scoring and maximum total points are the same as the regular Open class.

Wild Card Utility - is for any dog that is capable of performing the Utility exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person and may be entered in another class or classes. The Utility exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Utility A class, except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to skip one exercise and receive full credit for that exercise. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be skipped. If an exercise is skipped, it cannot be performed. If the handler chooses to perform all of the exercises, all will be scored. The exercises will be performed in the same order as the regular Utility A class. The point values for the exercises, scoring and maximum total points are the same as the regular Utility class. Handlers are allowed to praise their dogs during the performance of all Utility exercises except the signal exercise.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

CANINE COURTESY All dogs shall be kept under control at all times. You are responsible for picking up after the animals in your care.

PLEASE EXERCISE DOGS IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY There will be pooper scoopers and containers placed around the grounds. **PLEASE USE THEM.**

All regulations will be enforced by the Grounds Committee.

No dogs will be allowed on the show grounds except those entered in the show.

Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times.

Park at your own risk. In the event of inclement weather the grounds may become soft and vehicles can get stuck. Towing will be at the expense of the vehicles owner.

All person attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against Long Island Golden Retriever Club, Inc. or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
