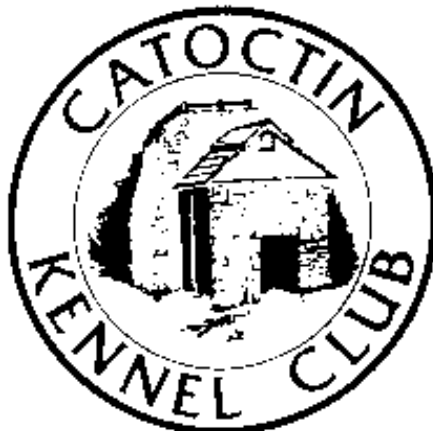

From the South: The "country route" a bit curvy and hilly in parts. I-270 to Urbana (Exit 26). West on Route 80 to Route 85 (approximately 5 miles). Left onto Route 85 South to Route 28 (approximate 5 miles). Right on Route 28 to Rock Hall Road in Point of Rocks (approximately 4 miles). Rock Hall Road intersects with Route 28 just prior to the railroad crossing. Left onto Rock Hall Road and left into the parking area.

OR if you prefer highway driving

continue North on I-270 to I-70 West toward Hagerstown. Upon entering I-70 immediately move to the right and take exit 52 to US 340W/US15 South toward Charlestown/Leesburg. Bear off on US 15 South toward Leesburg and follow directions below (From the North and East).

Access to show site will be available at 7:00 AM until 5:00 PM on Friday, November 27, 2009 and 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM on **Saturday and Sunday, November 28 and 29, 2009. Dogs must be removed overnight.**

RALLY ENTRY FEES: \$28.00 for each entry of each dog (includes \$3 AKC recording fee for Rally) in Rally Trial and \$25.00 each additional entry of same dog.

OBEDIENCE ENTRY FEES: \$28.00 for the first entry of each dog (including \$.50 AKC. recording fee & \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee) in each Obedience Trial and \$25.00 each additional entry of the same dog.

CLOSING DATE for entries 12:00 Noon, Wednesday, November 11, 2009 (at Superintendent's Office) after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

THE RALLY AND OBEDIENCE TRIAL will be open from 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

An **AKC RECORDING FEE of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00** will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3). All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a **\$20.00 collection fee** to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent to be advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
