Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in Regular Class, Best of Variety Competition or some other Non-Regular Class. Entry Fee \$10.00.

**Brood Bitch Class**, will be for Brood Bitches and at least two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of Produce. Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in Regular Class, Best of Variety Competition or some other Non-Regular Class.

Entry Fee - \$10.00.

As the Judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Variety by virtue of having won this class.

The Ag Center is located on County Road off Rt. 183 approximately 1 1/2 miles north of the Reading Airport.
