ROUTES TO THE SHOW

Pennsylvania State Farm Show Building, Giant Expo Hall, 2300 N. Cameron Street, Harrisburg, PA 17110

FROM PITTSBURGH AND WEST VIA THE PA TURNPIKE - Travel East on the Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 242. Take I-83 North to 2nd Street Exit (Exit 43). At first traffic light at bottom of ramp, turn right onto Paxton Street. At next traffic light (car dealer on left, restaurant on right), turn left onto Cameron Street. (PA Rt. 230). Follow Cameron Street approximately 1.9 miles, crossing over Maclay Street to Farm Show Parking lot on left.

FROM PHILADELPHIA AND EAST VIA THE PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE - Travel West on the Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 247. Follow I-283 North toward Harrisburg. Take I-83 North to Rt. 81 SOUTH. Travel I-81 South to Cameron Street (PA Rt. 230) Exit 67 (East) to Farm Show on right.

VIA ROUTE 81 (NORTH AND SOUTH) - Rt. I-81 to Cameron Street (PA Rt. 230) Exit 67 (East) to Farm Show on right.

VIA ROUTE 15 SOUTHBOUND (NORTH OF HARRISBURG) - Travel Route 15 South to Route 322 East. Follow Route 322 East to Cameron Street (PA RT. 230) Exit. Follow Cameron Street to Farm Show Building.

VIA ROUTE 15 NORTHBOUND (SOUTH OF HARRISBURG) - Travel Route 15 North. Exit at Rt. 581 East. Follow Rt. 581 as it merges into I-83 North. After crossing the Susquehanna River, take the 2nd Street Exit (Exit 43). At first traffic light at bottom of ramp, turn right onto Paxton Street. At next traffic light (restaurant on right), turn left onto Cameron Street (PA Rt. 230). Follow Cameron Street approximately 1.9 miles, crossing over Maclay Street to Farm Show Parking Lot on left.

VIA ROUTE 83 NORTHBOUND (FROM EASTERN MARYLAND/YORK PA) - Travel I-83 North following Harrisburg signs. After crossing the Susquehanna River, take the 2nd Street Exit (Exit 43). At first traffic light at bottom of ramp, turn right onto Paxton Street. At next traffic light (restaurant on right), turn left onto Cameron Street (PA Rt. 230). BATHING STATION - Outdoor dog bathing area available.

HANDICAP PARKING - Available upon display of a valid disabled placard or license.

SPECTATOR PARKING & ADMISSION - FREE parking on site. Overflow parking may be directed to other lots, and any parking fees for those lots will be set and collected by the Farm Show.

SPECTATOR ADMISSION: \$5 per person, age 18 and older. Under age 18 is Free.

FREE DAY PARKING - NO PASS REQUIRED

DAY CRATING/GROOMING

RV PARKING

- **Parking of RVs will begin at NOON, Tuesday, April 8, 2025 directed by Site Control Services.** DO NOT SELF PARK. Anyone attempting to park themselves prior to NOON, Tuesday, will be required to move as directed by Site Control and may also be required to pay an additional \$100 violation fee, if determined by Site Control and/or show giving clubs.
- Site Control has full authority over RV parking decisions.
- **Plastic and/or matting is required** under all x-pens, with or without shavings.
- RVs must be removed from the show site immediately after Best in Show on SUNDAY.
- RV electric is included in parking fee as available for OVERNIGHT parking; limited and first come-first served, no guarantees. Bring extra electric cords. Fees are the same with or without electric. Plenty of additional space available without electric.
- NO ELECTRIC available for day-RV parking.
- **Fee: \$62 per night, for online reservation.**
- **Fee: \$72 per night, without reservation payment upon arrival.**

RESERVED DAY PRIME PARKING

- Space is for entire cluster, all 5 days. Not available for less days.
- NO electric available for Prime Day Parking. Generators must use Gen-Turi type exhaust.
- **Fee: \$75 per vehicle** (box truck size, vans, etc.) NO RVs or trailers.

RESERVED INDOOR CRATING/GROOMING SPACE (10' x 10')

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

RAU DOG SHOWS accepts entries for AKC events in accordance with the latest Agreement, entry form instructions & "Rules Applying to Dog Shows". Should these rules be updated or changed the most recent AKC rules take precedent in the event of a discrepancy in this document.

CHARGEBACKS will be considered a violation of the entry agreement and will be reported to the AKC compliance department for disciplinary action. Outstanding bad debts are grounds for rejection of future entry by the club or superintendent under AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows C11 S15.

The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. **SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR** within a reasonable time, please notify Jim Rau Dog Shows, Ltd., 610-376-1880.

MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO JIM RAU DOG SHOWS, LTD. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. The Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2006 an administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
