CLASS ELIGIBILITY

Non-Regular Classes (Single Dog Entries)

Herding Titled Classes: Dogs and bitches that have an AKC Herding Started title or above are eligible to compete in the herding titled class. Dogs and bitches which have achieved a conformation CH or GCH should enter the Champion Herding Titled Class. Dogs and bitches may be altered. Winners are eligible to compete in Best of Breed.

Veteran Class: Dogs and bitches must be 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. AKC CH or GCH is not required to enter as long the animal is within age limits. Dogs and bitches MAY BE altered to compete in these classes. Winners are eligible to compete in Best of Breed.

Any undefeated dog or bitch that have competed at the show only in additional non-regular single dog entry classes may compete for Best of Breed. If a dog or bitch are defeated in an additional non-regular single dog entry class, they may NOT participate in Best of Breed EVEN IF the participant has entered both the Non-Regular class and Best of Breed. AKC Champions of record may be entered in any of these classes.

Non-Regular Classes (Multiple Dog Entries)

Stud Dog Class: for Stud Dogs and at least two (2) but no more than four (4) of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The Stud Dog cannot be shown as the Get for another Stud Dog. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of Get. Offspring only to be judged based on their merits. Each dog making up the Get must be individually entered in one of the Regular Conformation Classes, Best of Breed Competition or a Non-Regular Conformation Class (other than the Stud Dog Class) at this show.

Brood Bitch Class: same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get in the description above.

Dogs and Bitches may be altered to compete in these classes. As the Judge's decision in these Non-Regular Multiple Dog Classes will be based on the merits of multiple get or produce, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Points for Reserve

The BORDER COLLIE SOCIETY OF AMERICA will award, at its National Specialty, a three-point major to Reserve Winner's Dog and Reserve Winner's Bitch if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held. [Division 15 2023 point schedule as of May 16: 6 dogs are required for a five-point major, so the total regular National Specialty class dog entry must be at minimum of 12 dogs.]

RAMP INFO

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirneci dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows & Keeshonden. Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. Junior Showmanship judges should follow the above.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a celebration of the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handlers and is open to purebred dogs that are at least six months of age. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. **A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

CRUFTS CERTIFICATES

Recipients of Saturday's National Specialty awards of BOB, BOS, BBE, Awards of Merit and Selects are eligible for entry in Crufts as a US International qualifier. Certificates will be awarded to those winners; the certificate is valid for Crufts entry in either 2024 or 2025 and must be submitted along with each entry for Crufts.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club - PHONE: (919) 233-9767.

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Competition must exist for Best Junior Handler.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION

The dogs that win the 4 Bred By Exhibitor classes (puppy dogs, adult dogs, puppy bitches and adult bitches) along with any dogs or bitches entered for Best of Breed that are shown by their Breeder/owner will compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor. The winner of this award at the Saturday National Specialty will also receive one free AKC litter registration. To be eligible for Best of Breed BBE, one must check the appropriate box on the entry form indicating their participation. All BOB eligible entries will be indicated by a hashtag (#) in the catalog.

PEE WEE JUNIOR ATTRACTION

Judge Robyn Powley, Wilmer AL

Pee Wee is a fun and free Special Attraction for children aged 5 to 9, as a Pre-Junior Showmanship activity. The safety of all children, dogs and adults are the top priority. The ring will be managed by a licensed AKC Junior's Judge. The Judge will explain the process and give simple directions. There will be no showing of dog teeth/bites. Please note the following important information:

- Dogs must be at least 4 months of age
- Dogs must have a proper collar and lead.
- Border Collies with AKC, PAL, and ILP numbers are eligible.
- No bitches in season are allowed.
- Pee Wee and dogs must be accompanied in the ring by a parent or guardian or another appropriate responsible handler.
- At the Judge's discretion a second lead may be required to be put on the dog for additional adult control.

To enter, the child's parent or guardian must fill out a Pee Wee Entry and Release Form. Sign up at the show at the Club Table in the grooming room any time prior to noon central time on Friday, November 3, 2023.

All participating Pee Wee get a Rosette and prize. Currently BCSA is taking a headcount of those interested in The BCSA Store. If you think your child may participate, please note your interest in The Store so that we know how many prizes to have ready. Indicating interest in The BCSA Store does not equate to entry. The Child's parent or guardian must still fill out the Pee Wee Entry and Release Form.

Nor Cal Bulldogger will provide one-half price pictures of all children participating in Pee Wee.

PLUSH PUPPY

Plush Puppy is another fun and free Special Attraction for children up to the age of 5 years. The ring will be managed by a licensed AKC Junior's Judge. Exhibitors will show a stuffed animal (preferably a dog, but other stuffed animals will be allowed) on leash. The Judge will explain the process and give simple directions. The participant may be accompanied with a Parent or Guardian if that is desired.

To enter, the child's parent or guardian must fill out a Plush Puppy Entry and Release Form. Sign up at the show at the Club Table in the grooming room any time prior to noon central time on Friday, November 3, 2023.

All participants get a Rosette and prize. Currently BCSA is taking a headcount of those interested in The BCSA Store. If you think your child may participate, please note your interest in The Store so that we know how many prizes to have ready. Indicating interest in The BCSA Store does not equate to entry. The Child's parent or guardian must still fill out the Plush Puppy Entry and Release Form.

Nor Cal Bulldogger will provide free pictures of all children participating in Plush Puppy.

AKC SANCTIONED 4 & UNDER 6 MONTHS PUPPY ATTRACTION
