

ROUTES TO THE SHOW SITE

From East: Take the Long Island Expressway to exit 68 north (William Floyd Pkwy.). Turn left onto Longwood Rd. At end of Longwood Rd. turn left; entrance is immediately to your right.

From West: Long Island Expressway (495) to exit 66 north (Sills Rd.); turn left onto E. Patchogue Yaphank Rd./Sills Rd. Slight left to stay on E. Patchogue Yaphank Rd./Sills Rd. Continue onto Coram-Yaphank/Yaphank Middle Island Rd. Park is on your left.

Hiking, Camping, Mountain Biking, Bridle Paths, Picnicking

This 320 acre site is situated along the headwaters of the Carmans River. Facilities include campsites for individuals, youth group camping and club camping (10 or more units) and family camping, including 10 sites with water and electric hookups. Picnic sites and the George Broome Memorial Activity Building are also available. Adjacent to Cathedral Pines Park is Prosser Pines Nature Preserve, which features a majestic stand of white pines planed in 1812. Prosser Pines is a popular site for hikers and photographers.

Cathedral Pines County Park will be charging a \$9.00 entrance fee into the park. For those exhibitors that do not live in Suffolk County please bring your show entry to prove you are going to the show. Otherwise the park will charge you a \$15.00 entrance fee for non-residence.



RAMP INFO

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: AMERICAN WATER SPANIEL; BOYKIN SPANIEL; ENGLISH SPRINGER SPANIEL; FIELD SPANIEL; NS DUCK TOLLING RETRIEVER; WELSH SPRINGER SPANIEL; GRAND BASSET GRIFFON VENDEEN; WHIPPET; GERMAN PINSCHER; STANDARD SCHNAUZERS; AMERICAN STAFFORDSHIRE; IRISH TERRIERS; MINI BULL TERRIER (Ground/Table); SOFT COATED WHEATEN TERRIER; STAFFORDSHIRE BULL TERRIER; FINNISH SPITZ; AUSTRALIAN CATTLE DOG; ENTLEBUCHER MOUNTAIN DOG; FINNISH LAPPHUND; ICELANDIC SHEEPDOGS; MUDI (or Table); NORWEGIAN BUHUND; POLISH LOWLAND SHEEPDOG; PULI (or Table); SPANISH WATER DOG; BASSET FAUVE DE BRETAGNE (Misc.); NORRBOTTENSPETS (Misc.)

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: CLUMBER SPANIEL; LAGOTTO ROMAGNOLO; SUSSEX SPANIEL; BASSET HOUND; CIRNECO DELL'ETNA: KERRY BLUE TERRIER: BULLDOGS: CHINESE SHAR-PEI: CHOW CHOW: KEESHONDEN:

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breed.
