



- All dogs entered in or brought onto the ground of these events must be appropriately vaccinated against such diseases as parvovirus, distemper and hepatitis. State law requires that all dogs over 6 months of age be vaccinated against rabies. Proof of such vaccinations may be requested. All exhibitors should carry valid proof of vaccinations. You may also wish to consider vaccination against kennel cough, Lyme disease and leptospirosis.
- PRODUCTS containing ČBD of any kind may not be sold or consumed on the Fairgrounds. This includes dietary supplements, foods, beverages, topicals or any other items that include CBD regardless of the source. Promoters, exhibitors or vendors who attempt to sell or sample CBD products of any type will be asked to vacate the property.
- Participants and Visitors must respect the authority of both the Eastern States Staff and the Show Officials. Failure to do so will result in ejection from the show grounds and/or Event Committee Hearings. Participants and visitors must abide by posted signs on the grounds. Certain areas will be marked by Please Do Not Allow Animals on Grass and must be respected.
- Show Buildings are designated as NO SMOKING areas. The West Springfield Fire Department will enforce this regulation. Please cooperate
- Eastern States Exposition retains all food concession, beverage and catering rights on the show grounds. Catering of beverage and/or food services for groups is not permitted unless such beverage and food is arranged for and provided by Eastern States Catering services. This does not preclude individuals from providing their own beverages and food.

Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best of Breed judging on Sunday, October 13.

- Enforcement of the State Laws regarding Handicapped Parking areas will also be strict. Please do not park in these areas unless your vehicle is so designated, or it will be towed.
- START CLEAN STAY CLEAN. Handlers and exhibitors are required to clean up their grooming and parking areas after the shows & to keep them clean during the shows. Anyone in violation of this "Clean Policy Code" will be warned to clean his/her area. Should the violation continue, the set-up may be removed from the grooming area.
- Should the Show Bench Committee determine that any dog enclosed in a vehicle is in danger, we reserve the right to break into that vehicle. Anyone parking on the show site parking lots must accept full responsibility for damages should this occur and waive any claim for damages against the Golden Retriever Club of America® or its members.
- Exhibitor and visitor parking will be in designated areas only. No cones are to be used in these parking areas. No parking on roadways or next to buildings except where designated. Violators will be towed at the owner's expense.
- All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the AKC, the GRCA, Rau Dog Shows, all other contracted staff, Eastern States Exposition and its employees, and any workers and volunteers.
- The buildings at The Big E will open each morning of the shows at 6:00 AM and will close at 9:30 PM every night except on Thursday and Sunday. On Thursday, the Better Living Building will close one hour after the conclusion of the Top 20 and on Sunday, the Better Living Building will close two hours after the conclusion of BOB.

There will be no ringside crating.

Cooperation with all club members, Event Committee members, RV parking personnel and Eastern State Exposition Security is mandatory. Following instructions and directions is required at all times. Using rude, abusive, or foul language or arguing or behaving objectionably against club officials, RV parking personnel or Eastern States Exposition Security will result in the attendee being immediately subject to an Event Committee Hearing and/or being removed from the grounds. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.

No extended Flexi Leads allowed in any building.

When possible, please leave strollers outside. Do not bring them into the building.

No practicing in the rings at any time

- Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement."
- DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused.
 JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

 ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.
- ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.
 THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.
