Miniature Schnauzer (Friday Only) Competitive Veteran Class - For dogs 7 years of age and over the day of the show. Divided by sex. Eligible for Best of Breed(Cannot be Spayed/Neutered).

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Entries

Australian Terrier & Miniature Schnauzer (Friday Only) Brace Class - This class is for two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers (can be one handler). Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. Both dogs must be entered in a regular class, no extra fee for Brace class. Judging of this class will be after the Best of Breed Class. Brace Class must be entered on the regular form as an additional class.

Miniature Schnauzer (Friday Only) Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class - A class with the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch and two (2) of their get/produce. Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be entered on the regular form as an additional class. Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be shown in the ring with their get/produce. Owner of Stud Dog/Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the get. Judging of this class will be after the Best of Breed Class.

★AWARD OF MERIT★

FOR ALL BREEDS

Streamer Rosettes offered by Hatboro Dog Club in club colors, red and black, may be awarded at the judges' discretion. Dogs/Bitches awarded BOB, BOS, BOW, Select Dog and Select Bitch are not eligible for an Award of Merit. Awards of Merit maybe awarded as follows: under 5 specials present - none; 5-10 specials present - one, over 10-15 specials present - two, over 15 specials present - three.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

RAMP INFO

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: AMERICAN WATER SPANIEL; BOYKIN SPANIEL; ENGLISH SPRINGER SPANIEL; FIELD SPANIEL; NS DUCK TOLLING RETRIEVER; WELSH SPRINGER SPANIEL; GRAND BASSET GRIFFON VENDEEN; WHIPPET; GERMAN PINSCHER; STANDARD SCHNAUZERS; AMERICAN STAFFORDSHIRE; IRISH TERRIERS; MINI BULL TERRIER (Ground/Table); SOFT COATED WHEATEN TERRIER; STAFFORDSHIRE BULL TERRIER; FINNISH SPITZ; AUSTRALIAN CATTLE DOG; ENTLEBUCHER MOUNTAIN DOG; FINNISH LAPPHUND; ICELANDIC SHEEPDOGS; MUDI (or Table); NORWEGIAN BUHUND; POLISH LOWLAND SHEEPDOG; PULI (or Table); SPANISH WATER DOG; BASSET FAUVE DE BRETAGNE (Misc.); NORRBOTTENSPETS (Misc.);

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: CLUMBER SPANIEL; LAGOTTO ROMAGNOLO; SUSSEX SPANIEL; BASSET HOUND; CIRNECO DELL'ETNA; KERRY BLUE TERRIER; BULLDOGS; CHINESE SHAR-PEI; CHOW CHOW; KEESHONDEN

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breed. (6/24/24)

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a celebration of the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handlers and is open to purebred dogs that are at least six months of age. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
