Veterinary Examiners: Maryanne Mack, DVM

All breeds are welcome to participate, however official OFA certification is only open to Bulldogs, French Bulldogs, and Pugs at this time. Exams for all other brachycephalic breeds will add to the data and statistics necessary to qualify them for official grading in the future.

Detailed information regarding the exam protocol is available on the OFA Website at: https://ofa.org/diseases/rfgs/ and in the RFGS Overview Document, but in summary, exams are expected to last approximately 15 minutes and include a baseline physical exam and respiratory auscultation, a brisk 3 minute walk, and a post exercise respiratory auscultation. The exam is non-invasive and non-stressful.

Veterinary exam fee is \$50, OFA registration fees are waived.

The registration and exam process is paperless and requires owners to establish an account with OFA Online at: https://online.ofa.org where you can pre-register the dog and owner information.

- Log in to your OFA Online account, or if a new user, register for an OFA Online Account at: https://online.ofa.org
- From the owner dashboard, select CREATE NEW APPLICATION
- · Enter the dog's information
 - If the dog has an existing OFA record, you may be able to pre-populate many of the fields by entering the registration or microchip numbers and hitting the search icon
- · After entering the dog's info, scroll down and select Online Exams
