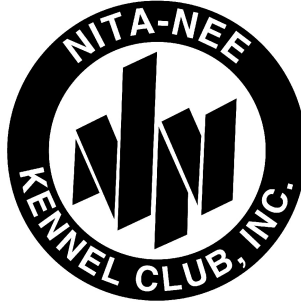

Grange Fairgrounds
169 Homan Lane, Centre Hall, PA 16828

The Grange Fairgrounds is located on the north side of Rt. 45 (Use Gate # 4), between Rt. 144 (Old Fort/Centre Hall) and Rt. 322 (Boalsburg, east of State College).

From I-80: Use Exit 161, south on Rt. 220, then Exit 73 to east on Rt. 322 bypass (*) left onto Rt. 45 East for approximately 8 miles, then left onto Homan Lane to Gate # 4 entrance of Fairgrounds. Dog show to the right side of fairgrounds. **NOTE:** For downtown State College, use Rt. 26, then east on Rt. 322 (business) to left on Rt. 45 East (Earlystown Road) to fairgrounds.

OR

From West - 80 E to Woodland Exit 123 then 322E toward State College to I99/US-322E Bus. Then 322E to Old Fort exit (Rt 45E) left onto Earlystown Road, approximately 8 mi, left onto Homan Lane to Fairgrounds.

From the South: (Altoona) Take I-99/Rt. 220 North to Rt. 322 East, then from (*) as above.

From the East (Harrisburg): Take Rt. 322 West, turn slight right onto Rt. 144 (not truck route) to Old Fort traffic light intersection; turn left onto Rt. 45 West for approximately 1/2 mi, turn right onto Homan Lane to Gate # 4 entrance of Fairgrounds. Dog show on the right side after entrance.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a celebration of the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handlers and is open to purebred dogs that are at least six months of age. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. **A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

AKC SANCTIONED 4 & UNDER 6 MONTHS PUPPY COMPETITION

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are four months and under six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. There will be a selection of Best of Breed Puppy in each Breed/Variety. All Best of Breed Puppy winners will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth. **Please Note - We will do our best to avoid scheduling conflicts between the 4-6 month Classes and the Regular Classes, however, if conflicts occur NO refund will be given.

CLASSIFICATION - Classes Combined (Dogs & Bitches) - Beginner Puppy, 4 Months & under 6 Months
Use regular entry form and mark 4-6 mos in Dog Show Class Box.

Entries will be taken through our Superintendent, Rau Dog Shows.
Use the Regular Entry form and indicate 4-6 month class in the Dog Show Class section of the entry form.

RAMP INFO

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: AMERICAN WATER SPANIEL; BOYKIN SPANIEL; ENGLISH SPRINGER SPANIEL; FIELD SPANIEL; NS DUCK TOLLING RETRIEVER; WELSH SPRINGER SPANIEL; GRAND BASSET GRIFFON VENDEEN; WHIPPET; GERMAN PINSCHER; STANDARD SCHNAUZERS; AMERICAN STAFFORDSHIRE; IRISH TERRIERS; MINI BULL TERRIER (Ground/Table); SOFT COATED WHEATEN TERRIER; STAFFORDSHIRE BULL TERRIER; FINNISH SPITZ; AUSTRALIAN CATTLE DOG; ENTLEBUCHER MOUNTAIN DOG; FINNISH LAPPHUND; ICELANDIC SHEEPDOGS; MUDI (or Table); NORWEGIAN BUHUND; POLISH LOWLAND SHEEPDOG; PULI (or Table); SPANISH WATER DOG; BASSET FAUVE DE BRETAGNE (Misc.); NORRBOTTENSPETS (Misc.)

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: CLUMBER SPANIEL; LAGOTTO ROMAGNOLO; SUSSEX SPANIEL; BASSET HOUND; CIRNECO DELL'ETNA; KERRY BLUE TERRIER; BULLDOGS; CHINESE SHAR-PEI; CHOW CHOW; KEESHONDEN;

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breed.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

Veteran Class for ALL BREEDS - For all dogs/bitches 7 years of age and older. May NOT be spayed or neutered. Eligible for Best of Breed.

Bred-by-Exhibitor Class eligibility: All dogs entered in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The Person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Amateur-Owner-Handler - For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler
