SET UP REQUIREMENTS FOR THE GROOMING/CRATING SPACE

The grooming areas in Ag-Hall will be clearly defined. All exhibitors must conform to the guidelines described and illustrated below to enhance the experience for all exhibitors. Please cooperate with the show committee and Kiarry personnel.

The layout plan shows that all grooming areas are to be laid out in a straight line with a row of crates on the left and a row of tables on the right. The crate row is 3 feet wide, the table row is 3 feet wide and an aisle between 1 and 2 feet wide.

Crate doors are to face the tables. Tables are to be set lengthwise in the center so that the aisle is free for traffic to walk through.

**We require hard crates and wire crates (size 300 & smaller) to be stacked.

***Some space is reserved by the cluster clubs for breeds holding specialties.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. Judges and Official parking will be in a designated parking area.
2. **Obedience/Rally exhibitors will be the only people allowed in the Obedience/Rally building from 5:00 PM to 10:00 PM on Tuesday, December 10, 2024. These will be the only people allowed in this building until the conclusion of the Trial on Thursday, December 12, 2024. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
3. Thursday, Friday & Saturday both buildings will be open from 6:00AM to 10:00PM.
4. Sunday, December 15, 2024 both buildings will be open from 6:00AM to one hour after Best in Show at which time every one must be packed and gone.
5. **DUE TO PAST ABUSES**, saving space in the grooming/crating areas WILL NOT be permitted. The crating area will be under the supervision and direction of the club members and Kiarry Enterprises. **ANYONE NOT ADHERING TO CRATING RULES WILL BE SUBJECT TO A BENCH SHOW COMMITTEE HEARING.**
6. Exhibitors with multiple crates MUST stack crates on top of each other and ALL crates MUST be arranged in an orderly fashion to MAXIMIZE the use of the LIMITED space available.
7. No Crates will be allowed in the aisles.
8. Due to space limits, no unentered dogs will be allowed in the building.
9. **No soft sided crates, crates must be stacked. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**
10. The use of flex-leads is prohibited in the Building.
11. No combustible decorations are permitted by order of the Fire Marshall.
12. "Daisy chains" of electric outlet power strips will not be allowed. Electric drops will be available on a first come first serve basis.
13. Private exercise pens will not be allowed inside AgHall.
14. Portable generators are prohibited inside AgHall.
15. Smoking is prohibited in AgHall.
18. Any exhibitor who fails to adhere to published, posted or verbal parking committee instructions and/or above listed crating instructions will be subject to a bench show committee hearing.
19. Overnight parking is a privilege extended by the Star of Bethlehem Dog Shows & the Lehigh Country Agricultural Association to its exhibitors. Failure to follow the instructions of officials on duty will result in forfeiture of parking privileges without refund of fees paid and the possibility of disciplinary action determined by the Event Committee. **Parking is strictly at the exhibitor's risk as the clubs accepts no responsibility for theft, damage or loss of personal property or the loss of or injury to animals in the care of exhibitors at these shows.**

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a celebration of the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handlers and is open to purebred dogs that are at least six months of age. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

RAMP INFO

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: AMERICAN WATER SPANIEL; BOYKIN SPANIEL; ENGLISH SPRINGER SPANIEL; FIELD SPANIEL; NS DUCK TOLLING RETRIEVER; WELSH SPRINGER SPANIEL; GRAND BASSET GRIFFON VENDEEN; WHIPPET; GERMAN PINSCHER; STANDARD SCHNAUZERS; AMERICAN STAFFORDSHIRE; IRISH TERRIERS; MINI BULL TERRIER (Ground/Table); SOFT COATED WHEATEN TERRIER; STAFFORDSHIRE BULL TERRIER; FINNISH SPITZ; AUSTRALIAN CATTLE DOG; ENTLEBUCHER MOUNTAIN DOG; FINNISH LAPPHUND; ICELANDIC SHEEPDOGS; MUDI (or Table); NORWEGIAN BUHUND; POLISH LOWLAND SHEEPDOG; PULI (or Table); SPANISH WATER DOG; BASSET FAUVE DE BRETAGNE (Misc.); NORRBOTTENSPETS (Misc.);

Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breed. (6/24/24)

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class. The calendar for this class will consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list, if the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3.).
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog All-American Dog/Mixed Breed - Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
