



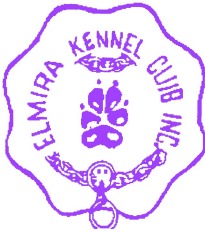

NEW YORK STATE LAW REQUIRES CURRENT RABIES CERTIFICATES FOR ALL DOGS IN PARK.

Only official cluster committee golf carts will be allowed on the show site.

"Motorized scooters, bicycles, golf carts and other non-registered motor vehicles are prohibited in Sampson State Park. No Riding of Bicycles or Motorized Bikes on Show Grounds during Show Hours. THE SHOW, OBEDIENCE & RALLY TRIAL will be open from 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.

AN AKC RECORDING FEE OF 50¢ & AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for the first entry of a dog & a \$3.50 service fee each additional entry of the same dog in an event will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check.

CHARGEBACKS will be considered a violation of the entry agreement and will be reported to the AKC compliance department for disciplinary action. Outstanding bad debts are grounds for rejection of future entry by the club or superintendent under AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows C11 S15.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards.

The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. **SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR** within a reasonable time, please notify Jim Rau Dog Shows, Ltd., 610-376-1880.

MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO JIM RAU DOG SHOWS, LTD. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. The Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a celebration of the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handlers and is open to purebred dogs that are at least six months of age. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. **A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS, or received payment for handling a dog.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

Non-Regular Classes involving Single Dog Entries - Where offered

Veteran Class (same class for Dogs & Bitches) - Where Applicable

For dogs and bitches 7 years of age and over on the day of the show, since the winners of these two classes are eligible for Best of Breed competition, they may not have been altered. See trophy list for breed specific divisions.

Hunting Class (same class for Dog & Bitches) - Where Applicable.

Class for dogs & class for bitches who have achieved an AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter or Master Hunter Title.

Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries - Where offered

Stud Dog - Class for stud dog and two (2) of their get. Owners of stud dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. Stud Dog must be entered on the regular form as an additional class and be shown in the ring with their get. Get must be entered in one of the regular or non-regular classes. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

Brood Bitch - same as Stud Dog except substitute brood bitch for stud dog and produce for get.

Note: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Brace - Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common ownership. The two dogs comprising a brace must be named at the time of the entry. If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each brace must be designated "Brace No. 1, Brace No. 2" etc.

NOTICE: Clubs using the Specialty rings may set up crates under the Specialty tent. However, within a half hour after the conclusion of each breed's Specialty judging, crates must be removed to allow the next club to use the space.

Rules and information applying to ALL specialty and supported entries offering the following classes at Wine Country Circuit in 2024.

For Specialty Shows, The Wine Country Circuit offers rosettes for the following:

SWEEPSTAKES

For Clubs who do not have a specific breakdown or classifications for sweepstakes money listed with their breed, the following will apply:

Division of Prize Money

The amount over \$10 of each entry fee will be retained by the specialty/supported entry club for expenses.

Puppy Sweepstakes

Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the regular classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and age division on the regular entry form under additional classes. Entry fee is breed specific.

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all registered dogs who are 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. Neutered Dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in the veteran sweepstakes. Entrants may or may not be finished Champions. The Veteran Sweepstakes classes will be judged prior to the regular classes. Veteran sweepstakes entrants do not have to be entered in Regular Classes. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" and age division on the regular entry form under additional classes. Entry fee is breed specific.

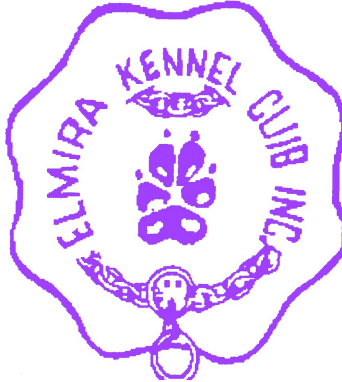
