Do NOT mail certificate with your camping form.

Campfires are allowed on sites with fire pits. Firewood is available to purchase within the park or from local vendors. It is illegal to bring firewood into the area from further away than a 50 mile radius.

Cornell University Animal Hospital will be the Emergency facility. Open 24 hours a day. It is located in Ithaca, NY about a one hour drive from the show site. Phone - 607-253-3060

Directions from the park: Turn right onto New York 96A S. Continue onto NY-96 S/N Town Line Road. Continue to follow NY-96S (About 29 minutes). Turn right onto N Fulton Street (about 3 minutes). Turn left onto W. Green Street (about 3 minutes). Slight right onto E. Martin Luther King Jr. St/E State Street (About 1 minute). Turn left onto Mitchell Street. Turn left onto Ithaca Road (about 1 minute). Turn right onto NY-366E/Dryden Road. (About 2 minutes). Turn left onto Tower Road (about 1 minute). Take the 1st right onto Campus Road. Turn left (Destination will be on the left).

Cornell University Hospital for Animals is the official veterinary care provider for the Wine Country Circuit Dog Show.

Cornell veterinarians are on site to triage any dog that becomes ill or injured during show hours. Emergencies will be referred to Cornell's Companion Animal Hospital (607) 253-3060.

Camping Information for 2024 New Information

No reservations will be accepted if received before Tuesday, August 13, 2024 with a post mark prior to Monday, August 12, 2024. Reservations must be sent with the "No Signature required" waiver. Please use internet tracking instead.

The Campground loops contains 243 sites with electric hookups. One camper per site. The overflow areas have no hookups. These camp sites are closer to the show site. No sites have water hookups but water is available at several places through the park.

Reservations accepted by mail until Wednesday, September 20th. After this time you may call the camping coordinator (Mona) at 607-738-6487.

Each site will only be allowed two extra motorized vehicles. One motorhome and two vehicles or if trailer, 2 vehicles included in camping fee.

Parties assigned electric sites will be charged \$200 for four nights. Overflow sites will be charged \$160 for four nights. If you pay for electric sites but instead receive a non electric site, you will receive a refund when checking in. **Anyone not staying all four nights will receive a non electric site.** All payments must be in US funds.

Generator use hours are 6:00 AM to 11:00 PM. This is enforced by the park.

Handicap sites are limited. Handicap Certificate is required.. There are NO handicap parking spaces for motorhomes on show site. Handicap parking for cars only. Once the handicap sites are gone, there are no other sites guaranteed so reserve as soon as allowed.

All campers not making reservations prior to the closing date will pay at the park on a cash only basis and any extra days other than Wednesday through Saturday night are paid directly to the park..

No Buses this year

"Height restriction for Underpass". The underpass on Route 96A, just north of the park has a height restriction of 12 foot 11 inches.

Due to the presence of wildlife rabies in this area, all campers must show a valid rabies certificate for each dog brought into the park. These will be checked at the park office when checking in. No dog will be allowed to stay in the park without a current certificate. Dogs must be kept on a leash in the park and no dog is to be left unattended in exercise pens.

To give you some indication of the distance in the park, it is exactly 8/10 of a mile from the entrance of Loop 5 to the show site. (See Map).

- 1.) All requests for campsites will be assigned in the order that they are received in the mail starting on August 13. (4 day campers having first priority as mentioned above.) **NO HAND DELIVERED FORMS ACCEPTED.** To have electric you must camp all 4 nights - Wednesday thru Saturday
- 2.) **Parties wishing to be on adjacent sites (ONE PER SITE) will have to send in their reservations together in ONE ENVELOPE. NO EXCEPTIONS.** This applies to breed specific groups also!
- 3.) **Site Requests are not guaranteed. NO site numbers given out before shows.**
- 4.) **All camping reservations are to be mailed to the name and address on the attached camping form. DO NOT MAIL OR CONTACT THE PARK FOR CAMP SITES FOR THIS 4 DAY PERIOD.** If you wish to arrive earlier in the week, we will try, if at all possible, to assign you to the same campsite that you will be camping in for the dog show. **If you wish to stay over on Sunday night or longer you may do so through the park office on Sunday afternoon.**
- 5.) All campsite requests are to be made out on the form enclosed or a copy of such.
- 6.) The New York State Park Police and Park Security will be patrolling the site areas to ensure that campsites are occupied only by the persons to whom the camping permit was issued. **No camper units or any other vehicles will be allowed to remain in the park overnight unless they are registered to and occupying a specific assigned site.**
- 7.) Sites will be held until 12:00 Noon ONLY after the check in date. (i.e., Reservations for Wednesday would be held until Thursday noon only). At that time the site will be reassigned to another party. (Late arrivals will be assured a site in the overflow areas).
- 8.) NEW YORK STATE PARK POLICE will be patrolling the grounds 24 hours a day. All speed zones and one way signs within the park MUST be observed and will be strictly enforced. They also have the authority to REMOVE ANY ONE WHO DOES NOT ABIDE BY PARK RULES.
- 9.) Sites must be occupied 24 hours a day (P.M. only).
- 10.) NEW YORK STATE LAW REQUIRES THAT ALL DOGS HAVE RABIES CERTIFICATES.

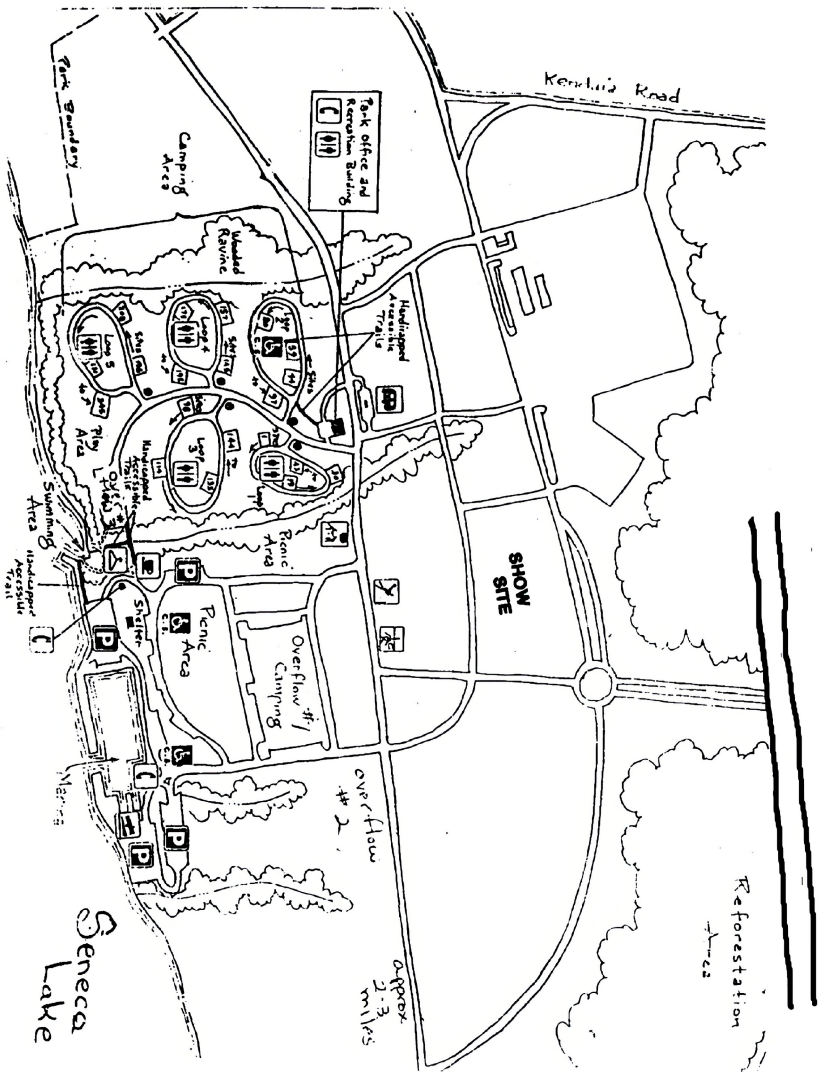

NO FLEXI-LEADS ALLOWED ON SHOW GROUNDS. NO POP UP TENTS ON SHOW SITE.

Only official cluster committee golf carts will be allowed on the show site and in park.

No Scooters allowed unless licensed.

All persons on the grounds of the Wine Country Circuit dog shows, waive the right to claim damages against a club member who must forcibly enter a vehicle to rescue a dog in obvious life-threatening distress.

"Motorized scooters, bicycles, golf carts and other non-registered motor vehicles are prohibited in Sampson State Park. This prohibition does not include electric wheelchairs or similar devices designed specifically for use by the physically impaired and being used by the person with the recognized handicap."

There will be NO generators/power supplied to the Grooming Tents

ALL NEW YORK STATE TRAFFIC LAWS as well as all park traffic laws will be strictly enforced and violators will be ticketed.

NO UNAPPROVED DOG ACTIVITIES will be allowed within the Sampson State Park boundaries for this four- day show weekend.

VENDOR SPACE (by invitation only).

MANDATORY RECYCLING is required in New York State Parks.

ROUTES TO SHOW

From New York State Thruway - Exit 42. Route 14 South to Routes 5 & 20. East on Routes 5 & 20 to Route 96A South. Continue on 96A South approximately 11.5 miles to Sampson State Park.

From South - from Watkins Glen take Route 414 North to Ovid. At the Red Light turn Left onto Route 96A North. Continue approximately 6 miles to Sampson State Park.

"Heights Restriction for Underpass" ...The underpass on Route 96A, just north of Sampson State Park has a height restriction of 12 foot 11 inches. If your motorhome is taller than this, and you are coming from the north, you will need to go to the towns of Waterloo or Seneca Falls and take Route 96 or Route 414 South, to the town of Ovid, then turn North (right) on Route 96A and go 6 miles to the park entrance.
